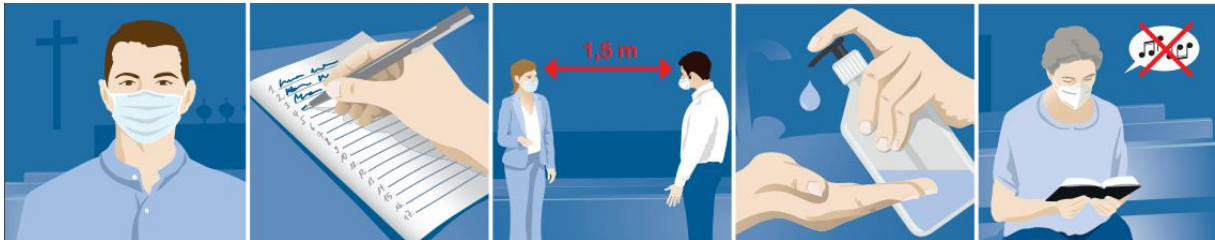


## STAY SAFE AT CHURCH

by being carefully and considerately



According to our COVID-Safe Plan please notice:

- We follow the the regulations of the government, the District Church and community.
- We stay at home when we feel sick or when we have been in close contact with a person who is positive for COVID-19
- Please pay attention to the general distance rules and hand hygiene.
- It is necessary to tell us your name(s), address and phone-number. (for tracking of infection chains)
- All attendees will need to wear a certified medical facemask (OP/FFP2) during the divine service and in the fellowship areas around the church.
- When sitting in the sanctuary, members should follow the directions of the ushers and stagger their seating in order to leave 1,5m between themselves, both across the pew/seats as well as in front and behind. Only, people of the same household can sit more closely.
- Given the high risks currently associated with group singing, please note that congregational singing is not possible at this time.
- When coming forward for Holy Communion, members should leave their facemask on and leave at least 1,5m between themselves and the person in front of them in line. When receiving Holy Communion from the minister, the members should extend the open palms of their hands as they approach to allow the dispensation of the wafer without touching and stay at arm's length away from the minister. The communion wafer should be carried away and taken once seated.
- After service – as you leave, please remember to maintain social distancing guidelines and refrain from touching anyone. A nod, wave, or bow with hand over heart are alternative and meaningful ways to greet each other.
